PASTORAL NOTE

PEACE FOR THE WORLD: THE COURAGE TO BE PEACEMAKERS

"Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace, goodwill toward men!" (Luke 2:14)

The angels' declaration was for the entire world, a divine vision for all of creation. The peace we are called to seek for our world is the active, hopeful, and sometimes demanding work of participating in God's mission of reconciliation. It is the outworking of the inner peace we find in Christ and the communal peace we practice in the church.

In a world marred by violence, war, systemic injustice, hindrance to immigration and environmental degradation, the promise of peace sometimes feels distant. Yet, as followers of the Prince of Peace, we are not permitted to be passive. Jesus himself said, "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God" (Matthew 5:9). To be a peacemaker is to step into the broken places, not with easy answers, but with the courageous love of Christ.

This work takes many forms. It is the prayer we offer for leaders and for victims of conflict. It is the letter we write to our Member of Parliament advocating for justice. It is the support we offer to refugee families. It is the choice to listen across political or ideological divides. It is the commitment to live sustainably on God's creation. It is the prophetic voice of the church speaking truth to power, just as the prophets of old and John the Baptist did in their time.

Be a peacemaker.

We offer a free lunch each Tuesday at noon, everyone is welcome to come and try our delicious cuisine which includes


many popular dishes: soup and sandwiches or a hot entrée also a choice of salads and a variety of different desserts.




